REGULATIONS (applicable to classes T8, T20, T45, T63 & T96):

- 1a. [Class T45 & T63] Each garment must be made from Pure Wool/Wool Blend of any ply and must have attached label from wool used or label or receipt from Woollen Mill.
- 1b. [Class T20] Knitted/Crocheted articles not acceptable.
2. An exhibitor may represent only one Society at Group level and one group at State level.
3. An article having won at a Show will compete at a Group Final, the winning article will then compete at the next Royal Melbourne Show.
4. An article, having won a State Final, is no longer eligible to compete in the competition.
5. Each article must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
6. If for any reason a winner is unable to compete at Group or State Final level then the second placegetter is eligible to compete.
7. A person will not be permitted to win at more than one show within the state in any one show year. Persons not adhering to this rule will be required to forfeit/refund prize money.
8. All work to have been completed within the last twelve (12) months.
