NOTE: OVINE BRUCELLOSIS TEST - Ram entries will only be accepted from accredited free flocks.

Age of Sheep to date from 1st April. Sheep in classes 1½ years and under to include sheep born on or after 1st April of the previous year to the date of the Show unless otherwise stated.

NLIS – all sheep are required to have a PIC tag attached when attending the show.

Health Statements – all entries need to have a signed sheep health statement and have the PIC number recorded on the entry form. If showing rams then the Bruc Accred. Number must be noted.
