Where there is only one exhibitor in a class there will only be one award/prize given.

REGULATIONS:

NOTE: OVINE BRUCELLOSIS TEST - Ram entries will only be accepted from accredited free flocks.

Age of Sheep to date from 1st April. Sheep in classes 1½ years and under to include sheep born 1st April 2022 – 31st March 2023 unless otherwise stated.

NLIS – all sheep are required to have a NLIS tag attached when attending the show

Health Statements – all entries need to have a signed sheep health statement and have the PIC number recorded on the entry form. If showing rams then the Bruc Accred. Number must be noted.

Waivers – Animal Handling waivers must be signed by all competitors handling sheep (available from our website).

Suffolks & White Suffolks: to be shorn after 1st August in the year of the show.

Pairs/Groups to be drawn from ordinary classes unless otherwise stated.

Groups to be 1 ram & 2 ewes (any age)

Sheep entered in classes for Any Other Breed will be judged according to breed (not an interbreed class)

Public Liability Insurance is the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

Champion Sash for ram and ewe for all breeds where applicable.
