- 1. **BY EMAIL** to **entries@benallashow.com** Fill out the appropriate entry form/s (1 per exhibitor), scan and send through with payment details. (More info is on the entry forms)
- 2. **IN PERSON** to the Secretary's Office, just inside the main gates of the Showgrounds, opposite the Rose Gardens. Office times are listed on the inside front cover of the Schedule.
- 3. BY POST to PO Box 168, Benalla 3671. Entry forms need to arrive by October 7<sup>th</sup> to allow for return of paperwork. \*\*Correct entry fees and a DL size Stamped, Self Addressed Express Post Envelope must be enclosed\*\*
- Entry fees must accompany the Registration Form or the entry will NOT be processed.
- No phone entries.
- Exhibits can be delivered to the Secretary's Office prior to deadlines. Please note Office hours on the Inside Front Cover.
- > NO REGISTRATIONS ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF JUDGING
- > Please note: very effort will be made to display all exhibits in space available. When space is limited all eligible exhibits will be judged but not necessarily displayed.

#### Regulations:

Only exhibits clearly marked with exhibitor's name, address & phone number will be accepted.

Please only use wool packs or clear wool bags.

Entry tickets to be securely attached to each exhibit.

Fleeces to be no more than 12 months growth, and to be shorn from sheep the property of the exhibitor for at least three months prior to the show. All fleeces to be lightly skirted and rolled in the ordinary manner. Exhibits containing skirtings will be re-skirted by the Stewards before weighing. Ram fleeces are not eligible for Most Valuable or Championship Fleeces.

No fleece will be allowed in more than one class.

The Committee reserves the right to retain samples of fleeces for future reference.

Trueness to type 10 Length 10 Soundness 10 Handle 8 Colour and bloom 6 Character 10 Density 6 **Evenness** 10 Clean Fibre Content 30 Maximum 100 Points

#### VAS Ltd Fleece Competition 2023-2024

Group Final: First \$25

State Final: First \$250 & trophy, Second \$150, Third \$50

1. An exhibitor having won the Overall Champion Fleece at a Show, will be eligible for the Group Final; the winner will then be required to submit a Fleece at the State Final.

- 2. An exhibitor is only eligible to represent one Group in the State Final.
- 3. Each fleece entered must be the bona fide product of the exhibitor.
- 4. If, for any reason, a winner is unable to compete at Group or State Final Level then the second-place getter is eligible to compete
- 5. All fleeces to be returned to the exhibitor at the completion of the competition.

North East Group Final: April or May 2024

State Final: late June 2024
