SPECIAL HORSE REGULATIONS:- TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Benalla Agricultural & Pastoral Society Inc will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by an exhibit. It shall be the condition of entry that each Exhibitor shall hold the society blameless or indemnified against any legal proceedings that may arise from such an accident.

NO REFUNDS will be made for class entry tickets unused or purchased in error.

ENTRY FORMS & WAIVERS – must be completed & signed by ALL persons competing or handling horses on the Arena(s). **There is a specific form for children under 18 - a parent or guardian must sign this form.** It is a condition of entry that each competitor must complete and sign an Entry Form and Waiver Form (2 forms in total) to ensure their results are valid.

Livestock & Horse regulations

CLASSES – except in the case of typographical error in the schedule, there will be **NO classes added on the day.**

ENTRIES ON THE DAY will have a number system. Exhibitors are responsible for providing stewards with correct ID number. Rings will not be held up waiting for exhibitors.

STALLS – LIMITED number of stalls may be available. Stalls can be only booked by calling 0415457235.

NO STRAW provided. **BYO STRAW. Stalls must be cleaned out after use.**

MEASURING – Current RAS and EFA Measuring cards will be accepted and must be produced on request.

DISTRICT / LOCAL EVENTS – Local or district events are for competitors residing in Benalla and District, or 30km radius.

PERSONAL PUBLIC LIABILITY RISK – is the responsibility of **ALL** exhibitors. All exhibitors compete at own risk.

COLTS and STALLIONS – All colts and stallions 2 years and over must wear a bit at all times, or adequate restraining gear.

OPEN / SHOW HUNTERS – per VAS Ltd rule 1st May 2017- **A competitor must choose to enter in classes as either a Show Hunter or a Show Horse, but not enter both. Once a horse has competed as a Show Horse or a Show Hunter at its first VAS event in a calendar year it must remain as a Show Horse or Show Hunter at VAS Competitions for that calendar year.**

CHAMPIONS – per VAS Ltd rule as of 1st May 2017 – **once a horse has successfully won a champion in its first open ring it cannot continue to compete in that equivalent section in other rings during the show.**

FIRST PLACE GETTERS- are eligible to compete in multiple open rings until successful as champion.

MEDICATIONS/SWABBING – Random swabbing may be enforced. Medication Control of horses may take place in accordance with the Equestrian Australia Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulations (1st edition, effective 5 April 2010 and updates) and the Equestrian Australia Medication Control System and Swabbing Policy (1 January 2015).

YARDS – As per EA rules, all yards must be of a fixed material and no electric fences are permitted. Yards are not to exceed 5mx5m.

CAMPING - There is **NO POWER** available due to OH&S.

2024 MEMBERSHIPS – can only be purchased up until Thursday 17th October 2024. (In person; or by mail, if received by Friday 5th October 2024)

The Benalla A & P Society Spring Show is a qualifier for the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.

- Benalla Agricultural & Pastoral Society Inc. reserves the right to remove any person in the state of intoxication, or behaving in a disorderly manner, from the reserve. (See Government Gazette No. 267 sections 2 & 23.)
- Ages of horses to date from 1st August.
- All animals or exhibits entered in competitive classes or ring events or parading (whether by invitation or entry) must be entered in the name of the bona fide owner or lessee. All animals must be named at the time of entry.
- No exhibitor or registered owner shall exhibit any animal recorded by any organisation or any affiliated breed society in any show or exhibition or advertise any animal in any paper, schedule, periodical or pamphlet under any but its registered or recorded name or as having attained any wins not recorded in the results of affiliated shows.
- A lease presented to VAS Ltd must cover each leased animal competing. Evidence of a lease or partnership must be presented on request from VAS Ltd. All benefits and penalties relating to a leased animal shall be attributed to the lessee. If the animal is registered with an affiliated Breed Society the lease must also be registered with that Society.
- Leases or partnerships must be for no less than a six (6) month period and a copy shall be lodged with Show Officials whenever an animal is entered for competition.
- No competitor or exhibitor shall deface or alter registration papers, height certificates or performance cards. Damaged cards, certificates or registration papers are not acceptable and should be replaced.
- Animals must be shown in their current recorded height group, breed classifications, age groups and classes. Horses must hold the relevant certificate issued by an official Measuring Steward using a proper measuring stand.
- Exhibitors must carry a current performance card for every novice horse and make this available in the ring upon request.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that the animal, exhibit and/or competitor are entered and shown only in the correct classes, and that the animal, exhibit and/or competitor is entered and shown under its full registered name where applicable.
- Hats and Safety Helmets:
 - A hard hat is generally described as a hunting cap, a bowler, protective headwear or a safety helmet.
 - Wearing a hard hat is compulsory for everyone competing on, working in or schooling or riding for any other reason a horse at a Show or in any area considered to be for whatever reason a part of the Showgrounds.
 - All riders 16 years and under must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headwear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds.
 - It is strongly recommended that all riders particularly those jumping horses wear protective headwear conforming to the current Australian Standard or an equivalent standard and that the headwear be secured by a retention harness.
- Any alleged acts of animal abuse are reportable during the event to the Society, supported by at least two other witnesses, or after the event to VAS Ltd in writing. Two separate letters must be received in writing by VAS Ltd from unrelated members or different families within fourteen (14) days of the date of the event, giving rise to the incident.
- The use of tranquilisers, stimulants, or any drugs capable of affecting the performance or behaviour of animals is forbidden.
- Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the owner's risk. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under veterinary supervision.
- Any Exhibit or Exhibitor deemed to be behaving in a Dangerous or Disorderly manner by the Stewards or Judge will be asked to leave the Showgrounds.

Off The Track Ridden & Led Series Qualifier Regulations

1. Open to any thoroughbred horse bred to race that has been stud book registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or Internationally. Registrations will be checked by VAS office.
2. Racing name to be used where appropriate. When entering if name is different to racing name, please provide the following details (if known): Racing name; Microchip number; Aust ID; Dam & Sire; Date horse retired
3. Riders to be 12 years and over on day of qualifying Show.
4. Colts/Stallions are not permitted to contest a series qualifier
5. Qualifying Shows must be VAS Ltd Affiliated
6. Ridden Series: Qualifying classes will be judged ridden; Led Series: Qualifying classes will be judged led
7. Once a horse has won a Ridden / Led qualifier, the horse cannot compete at another Ridden / Led Show in the same calendar year
8. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Racing Victoria's Off The Track Ridden / Led Open or Show Hunter Series State Final to be held at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.
9. To be judged as a good example or an Off the Track Thoroughbred (rather than riding horse/hunter types) with the following being taken into consideration: Thoroughbred qualities; Conformation; Manners, paces & performance; Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
10. Judge's decision is Final in Qualifiers and State Final
11. Show Qualifier Prizes: Sash, \$50 prizemoney sent out once qualification has been verified by Racing Victoria (Prize Pack collected at State Final)

REGULATIONS (VASL State competition)

1. This competition is a test of the dogs jumping ability.
2. The competition is open to all dogs.
3. The dog is permitted to jump on to or over the jump.
4. A dog who has won at Show Society level will qualify for the State Final Judging. A dog can represent only ONE Society.
5. All dogs not competing must be on a lead with a handler in the Marshalling Area behind the competition area. Competition area should be 15 metres long by 8 metres wide.
6. Only ONE dog may be loose in the competition area at any one time.
7. Every dog must compete at every height.
8. There must be a handler at the top of the jump to act as a catcher if necessary, and a handler as a catcher at the bottom. The dog's owner must supply the extra handler.
9. Each dog is allowed three attempts at each height if necessary.
10. In the event of two dogs jumping the same height, the winner shall be determined as the dog that took the least number of attempts from one jump.
11. A dog may compete on a loose lead or must be released at a minimum of three metres from the jump.
12. ANY MISHANDLING OR MISUSE OF A DOG WILL INCUR IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION.
13. If, in the opinion of the Stewards, a dog is unsafe to other competitors or the general public, it will be withdrawn from the Competition.
14. Classes - Small dog class under 50 cms. - Medium dog class 50 cms and less than 60 cms. - Large dog class 60 cms and over.
15. If, since competing at a local Show, a dog which has won in any of the classes has grown in height, that dog must compete in the appropriate class at the State Final.
16. A ladder will be provided for the handler.
